The organization is, however, deeply disturbed that he was only freed and allowed to leave Iran through a deal between Belgium and Iran, which enabled the premature release of Iranian intelligence agent, Azaadollah Azad, and diminished the effect of his conviction and 20-year prison sentence by a Belgian court for planning a thwarted bomb attack against Iranian dissidents in France. The circumstances of his release confirm Amnesty International's earlier concerns that the Iranian authorities held Olivier Vandecasteele hostage to swap him with Azaadollah Azad.

By transferring Azaadollah Azad to Iran, the Belgium government has contributed to a climate of impunity for the extrajudicial targeting of Iranian dissidents for extrajudicial executions, torture, and other ill-treatment, and undermined the rights of victims to justice, reparation and guarantee non-recurrence of violations.

Amnesty International warns that Iranian dissidents abroad will be exposed to increased risks of attack by agents of the Islamic Republic of Iran when the international community, including Belgium and other European governments, fail in their obligations under international law to duly punish extended extrajudicial executions and other gross human rights violations committed by the Iranian authorities extrajudicially to curtail freedom of expression and peaceful dissent.

Amnesty International is deeply concerned that the prisoner swap deals emboldening the Iranian authorities to continue to commit hostage-taking and other crimes under international law. To mitigate these risks, the Belgian authorities must urgently conduct investigations into whether the deprivation of Olivier Vandecasteele's liberty amounted to the crime of hostage-taking and promote accountability through both public statements and the investigation and prosecution of suspected perpetrators.

Amnesty International also urges the Belgian authorities to criminally investigate and issue arrest warrants for officials and others against whom there is sufficient admissible evidence of responsibility for torture, enforced disappearance or other crimes under international law against Olivier Vandecasteele, on the basis of the principles of universal jurisdiction and passive personality jurisdiction.

Amnesty International welcomes the release of Belgian and Dutch citizen Olivier Vandecasteele and is pleased he will soon be with his family in Belgium. He had been unjustly imprisoned in Iran since February 2022 and subjected to enforced disappearance, torture and other ill-treatment.

The organization is, however, deeply disturbed that he was not freed and allowed to leave Iran through a deal between Belgium and Iran, which enabled the premature release of Iranian intelligence agents, Asadollah Hajati, and diminished the effect of the conviction and 20-year prison sentence by a Belgian court for planning a thwarted bomb attack against Iranian diplomats in France. The circumstances of his release confirm Amnesty International's earlier suspicion that the Iranian authorities held Olivier Vandecasteele hostage to give him back Asadollah Hajati.

By transferring Asadollah Hajati to Iran, the Belgian government has contributed to a climate of impunity for the systematic targeting of Iranian dissidents for enforced disappearance, torture and other ill-treatment, and undermined the rights of victims to justice, reparations and guarantees non-recurrence of violations.

Amnesty International warns that Iranian dissidents abroad will be exposed to increased risks of attack by agents of the Islamic Republic of Iran when the international community, including Belgium and other European governments, fulfil their obligations under international law to duly punish, deter and eliminate extrajudicial executions and other gross human rights violations committed by the Iranian authorities extrajurisdictionally to crush freedom of expression and peaceful dissent.

Amnesty International is deeply concerned that the prisoner swap has emboldened the Iranian authorities to continue to commit hostage-taking and other crimes under international law. To mitigate these risks, the Belgian authorities must urgently conduct investigations into whether the deprivation of Olivier Vandecasteele's liberty amounted to the crime of hostage-taking and establish accountability through both public inquiries and the investigation and prosecution of suspected perpetrators.

Amnesty International also urges the Belgian authorities to promptly investigate and issue arrest warrants for officials and other agents whom there is sufficient admissible evidence of responsibility for torture, enforced disappearance or other violations of international law. The organization will continue to monitor the progress of the investigation and prosecution and will report on any developments.

Amnesty International welcomes the release of Belgian and German Oliver Vandecasteele and is relieved he will soon be with his family in Belgium. He had been unjustly imprisoned in Iran since February 2022 and subjected to enforced disappearance, torture and other ill-treatment.

The organization is, however, deeply outraged that he was only freed and allowed to re-enter his home through a deal between Belgium and Iran, which enabled the planned release of Iranian intelligence agents, Hezbollah fighters, and eliminated the effect of his detention and Oliver's prison sentence by a Belgian court for providing a sheltered home to a suspected Iranian assassin in France. The circumstances of his release confirm Amnesty International's earlier concerns that the Belgian authorities held Oliver Vandecasteele hostage to end his own assassination case.

By transferring Assadollah Saadi to Iran, the Belgian government has contributed to a culture of impunity for the extrajudicial targeting of Iranian dissidents for their political, religious, cultural, and other imprisonment, and undermined the rights of victims to justice, reparation and guaranteed non-recurrence of violations.

Amnesty International urges the Iranian dissidents abroad not to succumb to increased fear of arrest by agents of the Islamic Republic of Iran, and the international community, including Belgium and other European governments, to do their part to ensure that the Iranian authorities are held accountable for their human rights violations committed by the Iranian authorities, including the denial of freedom of expression and peaceful assembly.

Amnesty International is deeply shocked that the prisoner swap has empowered the Iranian authorities to continue to commit hostage-taking and other crimes under international law. To mitigate these risks, the Belgian authorities must urgently conduct investigations into whether the exchange of Oliver Vandecasteele is fully accounted to the crime of hostage-taking and should be prosecutable through both courts systems and the investigation and prosecution of suspected perpetrators.

Amnesty International also urges the Belgian authorities to promptly investigate and issue arrest warrants for officials and military personnel who are suspected of involvement in the abduction, detention, torture, and other human rights violations under international law against Oliver Vandecasteele, on the basis of the evidence of his arrest, detention and torture in Iran since February 2022.
